**Minutes Chitterne Annual Parish Meeting of the Electorate

**Welcome and acceptance of apologies.** Cllr Kent welcomed residents to the Parish meeting. Cllr Christopher Newbury, Unitary member, had sent his apologies.

**Chairman's Report.** Cllr Kent read his report for the year, see separate report attached.

**Open Forum.**

Members of the public asked: -

- 1) If the new play equipment would be installed by July.
- 2) Whether there are disclaimers at the entrances to the play park/sports field.
- 3) As there are allotment vacancies, would the Council like an article placed in Chit Chat.
- 4) A suggestion of having more regular 'clean up' days concentrating on different areas of the village.
- 5) Were the Parish Council responsible for the area where the multiplay had been removed, should an accident occur.

The Parish Council responded: -

- 1) It is hoped it will be installed in June; the Clerk would advise if there are any delays.
- 2) The current notice is insufficient, new ones are to be sourced and put in place.
- 3) Currently there are no Council allotments available, however the suggestion of a waiting list would be included in Chit Chat (a private landowner had land she wished to let for 'allotment' activities)
- 4) The suggestion was discussed and would be considered.
- 5) The area is taped off, further signage would be put up to deter people from entering, pending completion of the works.
